1	Take, evaluate, and record obstetrical/gynecological histories.				
2	Perform physical examinations required to evaluate obstetrical/gynecological problems.				
3	Perform standard OB/GYN examinations.				
4	Order and interpret appropriate laboratory studies, x-rays, electrocardiograms, and other special examinations.				
5	Collect specimens for pathologic examinations, including PAP smear.				
6	Analyze and interpret data, formulate diagnoses and problem lists, and establish plans for the management of obstetrical/gynecological health problems.				
7	Treat problems within his/her scope of competence and exercise judgment on problems requiring consultation, referral, or evaluation				
8	Initiate consultation requests to specialists and other health professionals including physical therapists, occupational therapists, dieticians, etc.				
9	Counsel patients on obstetrical/gynecological problems, use of medications, expected effects of treatment, diet, and other health maintenance matters				
10	Provide consultations on complex obstetrical and gynecological problems to other health care providers.				
11	Perform health maintenance for well patients, including administering or supervising immunizations.				
12	Manage common obstetrical/gynecological problems encountered in primary care clinics, including gynecological and complicated prenatal problems.				
13	Educate appropriate groups on health matters such as pregnancy, childbirth, family planning, care of newborn, child rearing, cancer health maintenance, and use of community resources.				
14	Counsel family planning, including prescribing of oral contraceptives, fitting diaphragms, inserting and removing intrauterine devices.				
15	Manage selected chronic gynecological illnesses.				
16	Prescribe medications as determined by the health center's formulary.				
17	Manage common pregnancy related behavioral or psychosocial problems including crisis intervention and short term individual, family, and marriage counseling.				
18	Perform and interpret colposcopic examinations.				
19	Perform endometrial biopsies.				

- Applicant attests that clinical training provided adequate instruction and experience for requested privileges.
- Any restriction on clinical privileges granted is waived in an emergency situation.
- Clinical privileges expire and must be renewed after two years.
- Signatures of applicant and Chief OB/GYN Officer affirm the ability of applicant to perform the mental and physical tasks necessary for the scope of practice requested.
