Jillian Hopewell Fellowship Award - Application Process

Eligibility

There are two types of people considered eligible for this award:

- 1) MCN employees (part- or full-time) who are pursuing training or education that relates to health justice and migrant health, and who complete the application.
 - Example 1: Employee 1 begins a two-year training program to get a master's in public health, studying part-time while also working full-time with MCN. After acceptance to her program, she applies for the Jillian Hopewell Fellowship. She receives the award to help pay for her studies.
 - Example 2: An employee who is working on data analysis for MCN participates in a one-year training course to develop those skills for their work with MCN.

Ineligible: Employees who have not yet applied for their training/education, employees who have completed their training/education.

2) MCN interns who demonstrate a commitment to health justice and whose internship will focus on migrant health, and who complete the application. Interns located near a physical office location are preferred, however remote interns are also encouraged to apply. A 175-hour time commitment is required for the full award amount.

Ineligible: Interns who are receiving funding through any source, other than MCN, for their internship (e.g. Through the College/University of attendance).

Award

The maximum award per person is up to \$3000 as a lifetime awarding for an MCN employee, and up to \$1500 for an intern (for a possible total of \$2500 when combined with an intern stipend).

An individual is not eligible for more than one award.

After the internship term, interns may present their projects, receive a certificate, and earn a spot on the MCN website that details their project or internship activities.

Timeline

Applicants must complete a one-page application. Applications will be open on a semester-basis for interns (Spring, Summer, Fall) and on a rolling-basis for staff.

After the application is submitted, it will be reviewed for completion. If there are incomplete areas, the applicant will be contacted to fill incomplete sections and resubmit.
